# IB Risk application and interview process

## J.P.Morgan

#### 1. Online application form

Visit the <u>Apply Now</u> section of the careers website and complete the application form for opportunities in IB Risk.



#### 2. Online numerical test

After you have submitted your application, you will be invited to complete an online numerical test. The test is 25 minutes in length and you are given five working days in which to complete it. Visit our <u>Advice Centre</u> for hints and tips about online numerical tests.



#### 3. Application review

After successfully completing your ONT, your application is reviewed by a member of the business. They will consider your academic background, previous work experience, extracurricular activities and motivation to work for J.P. Morgan in IB Risk.



#### 5. Assessment centre

The assessment centre lasts a full day. Candidates are asked to complete a variety of exercises including:

#### Case study

Candidates are asked to perform tasks similar to those an IB Risk Analyst would perform in their job. Pre reading is provided before the assessment centre.

#### Role play

Leads on from the case study - working with the same case. Students are asked to present to an IB Risk Officer.

#### **Group exercise**

Working to a brief, candidates discuss the various aspects of that brief within a group exercise environment.

#### Interviews

Two competency based interviews with representatives of varying levels from the IB Risk department (Associate to Managing Director).



### 4. First round interviews and numerical test

Our first round interview stage consists of two competency based interviews with representatives of varying levels from the IB Risk department (Associate to Managing Director). The interviews will last approximately 30 minutes each.

You will also be asked to complete a further in-person numerical test to check consistency.



#### 6. Offer

Candidates will be informed whether they have been successful in the process within 72 hours of completing the assessment centre.
